



## Student Resource Scheme 2026 –Year 10

The purpose of the scheme is to provide the parent/carer with a cost-effective alternative to purchasing the prescribed textbooks, resources, consumables and/or materials from elsewhere, through reduced prices gained from the school's bulk purchasing processes.

In recognition that these costs can be high, Mareeba State High School operates a Student Resource Scheme that enables a parent/carer to enter into a written agreement with the school that, for a specified annual participation fee, provide the necessary resources and consumables as outlined in the scheme.

Payment of the participation fee and Participation Agreement Form is a requirement for participation in the scheme and continued participation. Students will not be able to participate in non-curriculum activities if there are outstanding fees or have an outstanding payment plan. A parent/carer who does not wish to participate in the scheme shall inform the school in writing. If the parent/carer does not wish to join the scheme then it is their responsibility to provide the student with all items that would otherwise be provided to the student by the scheme as detailed below.

Student Resource Scheme (SRS) charge consists of 2 schemes, Core SRS fees & Elective SRS fees.

For 2026, Year 10s have no Core SRS fees, however there will be Elective SRS fees.

New students starting after 1<sup>st</sup> March will be charged pro-rata of the Core Student Resource Scheme from the enrolment start date. These students will not have the allowance deducted from the scheme unless the student comes from a non-state school.

The fees are to be paid in full by **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026** or the Parent/Carer to enter into a Payment Plan which can be done through Centrelink payments, direct deposits or School Payment Plan.
