Availability is conditional upon acceptance of the following conditions: -

- The student genuinely wants to be part of a Tablelands Sporting Team and will only withdraw for exceptional reasons. Frivolous withdrawal will result in exclusion from all District Sporting Teams for a 12-month suspension period.
- Withdrawing from a team with an **exceptional reason** must occur **3 full school days** prior to the event. Extenuating circumstances will be accepted, but please notify the District Secretary and District Coach as early as possible to allow as much time as possible to organise a replacement.
- All monies (if required) must be returned by the due date.
- Members of the District Team are required to attend all training sessions if they have been allocated for that sport. Members of the team should only miss a training session due to extenuating circumstances which need to be communicated to the district coach **3 full school** days prior to the training day. A failure to attend training sessions will result in a shadow player replacing your position in the team. Students will need to organise private transport to and from training sessions.
- Students will be required to be absent from school on the day (or part of the school day) of the Peninsula (Regional) Sporting Championships/Trial.
- Students will need to organise private transport to and from the Peninsula Championship venue. There may be some exceptions for some sports where buses have been hired to transport large numbers of students for that specific sport's Peninsula Championships.
- Students who are selected in a District Sporting Team are expected to abide by the Queensland Representative School Sport (QRSS) Code of Conduct. Students and their parents must read the attached Code of Conduct and sign the agreement at the bottom of the page indicating their commitment to abide by the level of expected behaviour when participating in School, District, Regional and Queensland Representative School Sport events.

CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code Of Conduct sets out what is expected of students in terms of participating in Queensland Representative School Sport (QRSS) events, and the range of consequences for not honouring the code.

As a Team Member:

- □ Take responsibility for your own behaviour and performance.
- □ Compete by the competition conditions and rules.
- □ Never argue with the Judge's, Referee's or Umpire's decision.
- □ Control your temper no criticism by word or gesture.
- □ Work equally hard for yourself and your team your team's performance will benefit, and so will you own.
- □ Be a good sport. Encourage and support your own team members.
- □ Show respect for yourself, your team mates, officials, your opponents and their skills.
- Behave in a manner that respects the rights of others
- □ Smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages, use of illegal substances and substance abuse is strictly forbidden.
- □ Wear the official team uniform at all times, as directed by team management/officials.
- □ Check-in and check-out with team management/officials.
- **Stay in the designated team area and support other team members during times when you are not competing.**
- □ Follow all directions of team management/officials.
- □ If an assessment piece is due, a negotiated time must be made with the teacher on an appropriate re-submission time.

Consequences for student breaches of this code

District Convenors, Coaches and Managers may deal immediately with any breaches of this code by imposing appropriate consequences, including not playing remaining fixtures, notification of parents, and being sent home at your parent's cost. The Tablelands 10-19Years District School Sport Board is responsible for imposing longer term consequences such as exclusion from participation in any further Tablelands Sporting Trials for the 12-month suspension period.
